



Shotgun was written by George Ezra, Fred Gibson and Joel Pott and appeared on his second album, *Staying at Tamara's*. It was George Ezra's first number 1. George was inspired to write the song whilst visiting Barcelona. The places George visited often influenced his songs. Having visited Australia, apparently the *'yellow and green'* in the lyrics of Shotgun, refer to the yellow and green on the Australian flag. As part of his tour last year, George Ezra performed at the Bonus Arena inHull. Use this information to help with the crossword below.
