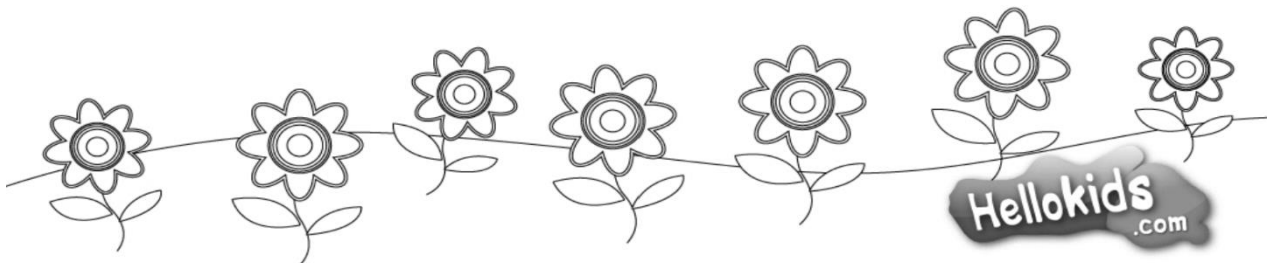

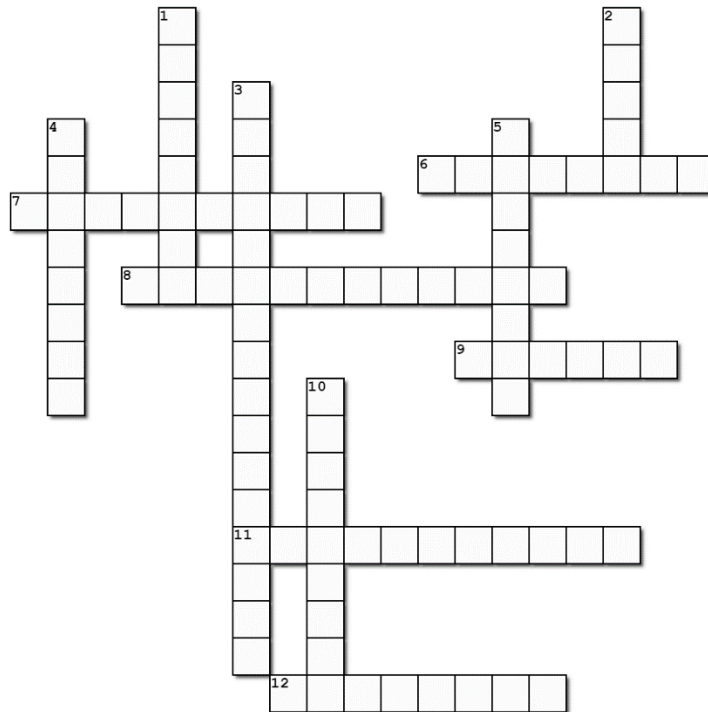


Lean on me



Lean on me was written by American singer-songwriter Bill Withers. It was the first single to be released from his second album *Still Bill* in 1972 and was recorded with musicians from *Watts 103rd Street Rhythm Band*. Bill Withers grew up in the mining town of *Slab Forks, West Virginia*. After he moved to *Los Angeles*, he missed the community spirit of his childhood town. Sitting at his piano, the phrase *Lean on Me* came into his head and he was inspired to write the song. Use this information to help you with the crossword below.

Lean On Me



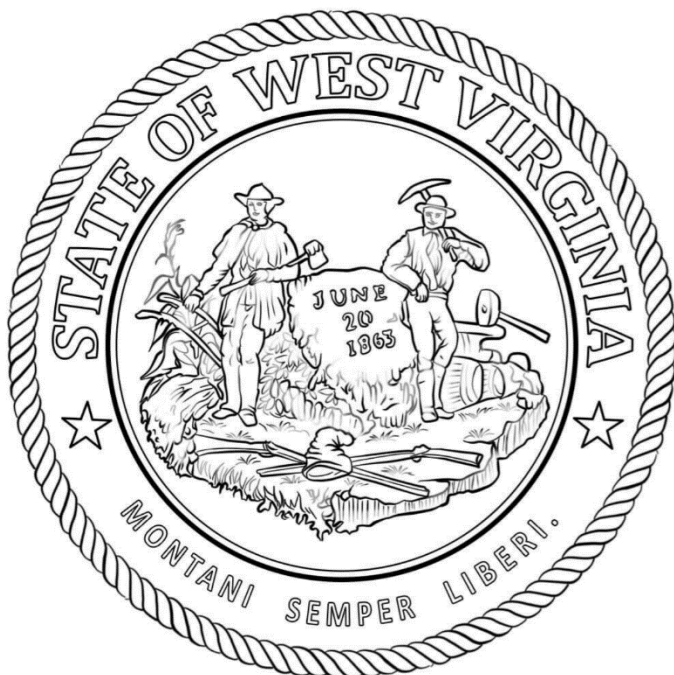
