## <u>Week 10 – Heroes (We Could Be)</u> <u>Listening Activities</u>

*Heroes (We Could Be)* was released by Swedish DJ and Music Producer **Alessandro Lindblad** under his stage name **Alesso**. It featured vocals from the Swedish singer **Tove Lo**, who also co-wrote the song. The Chorus uses lyrics featured in **David Bowie**'s 1977 song Heroes, which he co-wrote with **Brian Eno**. This is why they are both also credited as co-writers of Alesso's 2014 track. Listen to *Heroes (We Could Be)* and answer these questions:

- 1. What genre do you think the song belongs to?
- 2. The first line of the chorus states '*We could be heroes*'. What do you think this means?
- 3. Read the lyrics of the song. Tove Lo, who wrote the lyrics was inspired by a TV show about people with superpowers. She remembered being a kid and wishing that she could do anything, like a superhero. Do you think the lyrics reflect this?
- 4. The song has a strong dance beat and a prominent electronic sound. Can you hear this? What instruments can you hear?
- 5. Can you think of any other dance tracks?
- 6. Can you identify the structure of the song using the terms: Intro, Verse, Pre-Chorus, Chorus and Bridge or Middle 8?
- 7. The song features some lyrics that are shared with David Bowie's song *Heroes*. Listen to this song as a contrast. Do you like it? Which do you prefer?
- 8. Do you like the song Heroes (We Could Be)? Can you describe why?

## Heroes (We Could Be) – Did you know?

*Alesso* (Alessandro Lindblad) is a DJ who is famous for dance tracks and collaborations with other artists, such as *David Guetto*, *Calvin Harris* and *Anitta*. His music covers the genres *Progressive House*, *Electro House* and *Pop*. You can hear the electronic elements in his music, such as a drum machine, synthesiser, sequencer and sampler, which are mixed on a **Computer** or **Turn Tables**.
