## Week 13 – Wonder Listening Activities

Wonder was released in 2012 by British DJ, record producer, songwriter and musician **Shahid Khan**, a.k.a. Naughty Boy, featuring vocals by Emeli Sandé. It was written by both Shahid and Emeli, alongside Hugo Chegwin and Harry Craze. Listen to Wonder and answer these questions:

- 1. What genre do you think the song belongs to?
- 2. The line 'We are full of wonder' keeps repeating throughout the song. What do you think this means?
- 3. Read the lyrics of the song. What do you think the message of the song is?
- 4. This song has been created by the DJ *Naughty Boy* using audio software. Can you hear the electronic elements in the song?
- 5. On Day 5, the Albemarle Broadband version of this song is released. Listen to this and compare it with the original. What makes it different to the original?
- 6. Can you think of another *Sing for Hull* song that was also a dance track? Can you spot any similarities between that song and *Wonder*?
- 7. Can you identify the structure of the **original** song using the terms: Intro, Verse, Chorus, Bridge and Outro?
- 8. Listen to the last line of the Bridge. What does *Emeli Sandé* do to the melody to change it and add some variety? Listen to the rest of the song after the bridge. Can you hear other parts where she changes the melody line?
- 9. Do you like the song Wonder? Why?

## Wonder - Did you know?

**Naughty Boy** (Shahid Khan) is famous for his collaborations with other artists. A **collaboration** is when two separate artists come together to create a record. This is very common between DJs and singers. In *Wonder, Naughty Boy* collaborated with *Emeli Sandé,* who co-wrote the song and provided the vocals. Other artists he has worked with have included *Gabrielle, Sam Smith, Wiley* and *Ed Sheeran*. He also co-writes songs for other artists to record and co-wrote *Emeli Sandé's* songs *Clown* and *Daddy*.
